And they were astonished beyond measure, saying, "He has done all things well."

Mark 7:37

Strange as it seems, Jesus made a difference on three occasions with his spittle. He used His saliva three times in healing the sick. The first was the deaf and mute man in Mark 7. Jesus took the man away from the crowds, spat, and touched the man's tongue, healing him. In the net chapter, Jesus spat on a blind man's eyes, restoring his sight. And in John 9, Jesus healed another man by spitting on the ground, making mud, and spreading it across the man's eyes. When the man washed it off, he could see.
